Who died MARCH 10, 1815 PATIENT and in the Revolutionary War Service until his discharge Dec. 30, 1777...unless you know where it is and can take me? If we can locate the site, then a suitable stone can be erected to his memory.

I do hope Mrs. Day (Hannah B. Goold Day) may have had in her keeping some of the family records...so you can help us with this?

Sorry to have to write to you as complete strangers...but if you are relatives of hers, Day...you may not be strangers at all??
