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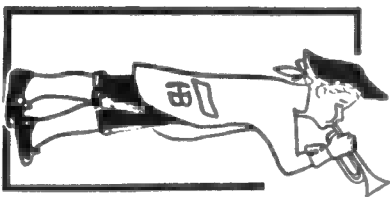

The Funeral of Rev. Albert Gould. Appropriate services were held in memory of Rev. Albert Gould in Trinity Church, Cambridge, on Thursday, the 20th.

He was buried in Winchendon.

Mrs. Abbie Elinora Booth, daughter of the late Rev. Albert Gould, of the New England Conference, died very suddenly at her home in Chicopee, on the night of Apr. 16. Her unexpected decease is a deep affliction to her husband; brother, Albert E. Gould of North Adams; and sisters, Mrs. Hopkins band; brother, Albert E. Gould of North Adams; and sisters, Mrs. Hopkins of North Adams; and Mrs. Francis Norton of Chicopee; and widowed mother. Funeral services were held Apr. 19 in Chicopee, and burial was on Friday, Apr. 20, in Winchendon.

Albert E. Gould, who died yesterday afternoon, was born in Saxonville, Mass., 40 years ago, and was the son of Rev. and Mrs. Albert Gould. His father was a Methodist minister. Mr. Gould's wife was Miss Harriet Wolcott of this city, whom he married Feb. 14, 1893. Besides his widow, he leaves a young daughter. He is also survived by his mother who lives in Chicopee; and two sisters, Mrs. F. H. Norton of Chicopee and Mrs. George Hopkins of Pasadena, Calif. Burial will be in Southview Cemetery.

Mary Emma Gould Norton, wife of Francis H. Norton, and daughter of Rev. and Mrs. Albert Gould, was born at Cherry Valley, Mass., Apr. 13, 1861, and died at her late home in Chicopee, Mass., Thursday, Apr. 26, 1917. Besides her husband, her mother and a sister, Mrs. Jennie Gould Hopkins of Pasadena, Calif., survive her. A highly gifted and honored daughter of Methodist parsonage, she became the wife of Francis H. Norton, Dec. 21, 1880, and made her home in Chicopee until her death. For many years she was president of the Ladies' Aid Society of the Central Methodist Church. Interment was in Fairview Cemetery.

Caroline, widow of Edward Loud of Winchendon, Mass., died Sunday, May 10, 1903, in her 79th year. She was one of ten daughters born in Putney, Vt., to Benjamin and Caroline Joslin, all of whom married into good homes. She married Mr. Loud in 1851, and made a home to which came two daughters, the eldest of whom died in infancy. A boy was adopted, who now resides in London, England; the daughter, Hattie, is now Mrs. Tees, with whom she lived.

Mrs. Adelaide L. Shaw, aged 79 yrs., widow of Jerome V. Shaw, died suddenly of heart disease Friday morning in her home on the new road to the railroad station. Mrs. Shaw was born in Putney, Dec. 16, 1840, and was one of 10 sisters, daughters of Benjamin and Caroline (Kumtill) Joslyn. The only survivor is Mrs. Abbie Gould of Pasadena, Calif. On June 7, 1865, she married Jerome V. Shaw, who died June 2, 1905. Most of their married life

was spent on the Great Meadow in East Putney. They had one daughter, Emma Louise Shaw, who married George T. Aplin of East Putney, June 21, 1894, and died July 24, 1895. Mrs. Shaw leaves one brother-in-law, Theodore T. Lord, of this village, who with his wife lived next door. The funeral was held at her home Sunday afternoon, and burial took place in the family lot in Mount Pleasant Cemetery. The bearers were George T. Aplin, Frank Day, Rufus Jacobs, Raymond Willard, Walter Sabin, and Harry Piedalve.
